- * To prepare a proper teaching practice schedule,
- * To encourage reflective teaching and field-based learning experiences.

Suggestion - Dr. Shashi Bhushan Ray said that there is a need to provide genuine feedback in the lesson plan.

Agenda 8: Discussion on Value Added / Certificate Courses

Resolution -

The proposal for introducing value-added and Certificate courses was discussed. The BOS approved the initiation of:

- * Diploma in Guidance & Counselling.

The members suggested that additional certificate courses related to ICT, inclusive education, communication skills, and classroom management may also be introduced in future.
