Resolution- It was decided that Smt. Arpana Kumari will be nominated Member Secretary of Academic Council. All members agreed on this.

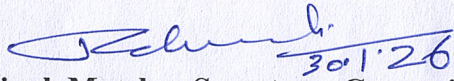

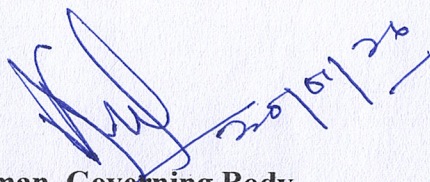
Resolution- It was decided that Shri. Birendar Kumar will be nominated member in Finance Committee . All members agreed on this.

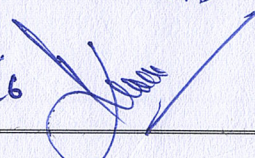

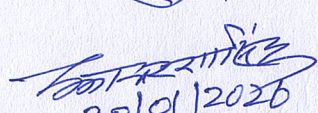
The Chairman and Member Secretary proposed a vote of thanks and expressed sincere gratitude to the Chairperson and all members for their valuable guidance and support.

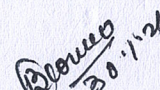

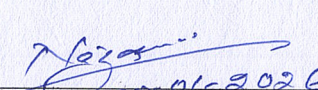

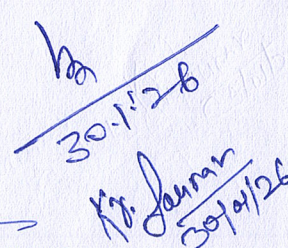
