In 28 January 2025, the St. Paul Teachers' Training College Family participated in a one-day symposium hosted by Grievance Redressal Committee at the PPN SINGH AUDITORIUM, where more than 20 Professors and 200 trainees shared and discussed leading practices to inspire and advance women's participation in the workplace. The aim of this program was to increase awareness of gender issues among the participants, especially students, and to resolve specific questions related to them. Dr. Rita Chauhan, an expert from the Department of Psychology, Samastipur College, Samastipur, participated as the keynote speaker in the symposium, who highlighted the importance of gender roles in today's society and the role of educational institutions in this direction. Elaborating on this symposium, she said that gender inequality is a big challenge.
