Nukkad Natak on World Population Day 11 July 2025

On the occasion of World Population Day, the college organized a street play (Nukkad Natak) to raise societal awareness about population control. The event was attended by the Principal, Dr. Roli Dwivedi, all teaching and non-teaching staffs, and trainees of B.Ed. and D.El.Ed. The trainees, after being wished luck and given a farewell send-off, proceeded towards Shankar Chowk in Birsinghpur. The group, which also included teachers, marched while chanting population-related slogans and holding corresponding placards, all while maintaining complete discipline. Upon reaching Shankar Chowk, they invited local villagers and school students to watch the play. The trainees received full support and morale boosts from the event coordinators, Mr. Tahseen Alam Qadri and Mr. Narendra Kumar, along with other teachers. The street play was well-received. The audience appreciated the performance and was deeply impressed by its message. They acknowledged that population explosion is a serious societal problem with potentially dire consequences if not controlled in time. Trainees Chandan Kumar, Shabnam Kumari, and Amit Kumar were particularly praised for their acting skills. Through their roles, they effectively communicated the critical message: uncontrolled population growth leads to crises in food and shelter. हिंदी दिवस कार्यक्रम 14 सितम्बर, 2025
